## Interviewing an Historical Personality

DIRECTIONS: Select one man and one woman from the appropriate time period that you are studying, Create an interview by using the guidelines below:

- 9<sup>th</sup> Grade - U.S. History 1: 1765 - 1865
- 10<sup>th</sup> Grade - U.S. History 2: 1870 – 1945
- 11<sup>th</sup> Grade - U.S. History 3: 1948 – 2009
- 12<sup>th</sup> Grade - World History: 1500 – 1850
- 12<sup>th</sup> Grade – Humanities: 1500 B.C. – A.D. 1450

- A. Your interview should be 10 questions and answers in complete sentences. All your questions and answers should include as many details as possible. In your interview show how that person dealt with a problem and tried to solve. This will allow the class an opportunity to get to know this historical personality. **Do not** ask him when he was born and when he died. Your questions should be about their importance in American History.
- B. Research the person using your textbook and other materials. If you have access to an online computer, use the internet.
- C. **This must be typed. The assignment is worth a test grade. You will be asked to present your interview.**
